Twmbarlwm is an enigmatic monument that has been the focus for activity from the prehistoric period to the modern day.

The talk will use many new images taken from a recent archaeological drone survey of the mountain and it will shed light on the monument's history from the Bronze Age burials and the Iron Age fortifications to the Norman reuse of the hillfort and the more modern management of the landscape.

Will and Amelia are both archaeologists with Cadw so you can be sure of a well informed, interesting evening.

The talk will end with a Q & A session.
