This talk retells the history of a unique Welsh medical unit in World War One. It was the only unit in the war to be recruited for Lloyd George's army by St John Ambulance and provided medical services at the battles of **Mametz Wood** in 1916 and **Pilckem Ridge** (1917). The talk covers recruitment, training and three years service in France and Flanders many of whom were from the **Ebbw Valley**. The talk makes use of diaries written by the men and includes a lot of personal detail as to how the men lived and served.
